

URGENT NOTICE FOR FULL COMPLIANCE OF COVID19 MEASURES AS MANDATED BY MALAYSIA'S NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL BY ALL CURRENT CONTRACTORS/VENDORS OF MALAYSIA AIRPORTS

Being an integral component of the delivery eco system that enables Malaysia Airports' smooth running of all major airports in the country, strict observance of COVID19 standard operating procedures for prevention is imperative and compulsory for all Malaysia Airports' current contractors and vendors. Any failure and/or non-compliance can be deemed as a form of contract breach. Consequently, all rights including imposing penalties up to immediate termination of contract will be applicable subject to the agreed terms.

Malaysia Airports urges all contractors and vendors to take a serious view on ensuring all mandated procedures, guidelines and regulations are adhered to without exception as to ensure operations and services can continue to be rendered at minimum risk of unwanted COVID19 infection at workplace.

Any party that is found to have contravened and/or failed and is subject to charges and/or consequences in line with 'Akta Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit 1988 / Akta 342 dan Akta Standard Minimum Perumahan, Penginapan dan Kemudahan Perkerja 1990 / Akta 446', is obliged to formally inform Malaysia Airports on such event at the earliest possible time. Failure to notify within a reasonable time can also be deemed as a contract breach.

Again, let us all ensure all procedures, guidelines & regulations on COVID19 prevention as updated over time by our nation's security council are speedily implemented irrespective of expense.
